

Blessed by the natural beauty of South Devon, surrounded by native wildlife and with gems such as Dawlish Warren Nature Reserve right on our doorstep, we recognise just how lucky we are. This is our glorious corner of Devon and it's here to share with you. It's why we're committed to securing a sustainable future for all our fomorrows.

Our brilliant biomass hub is just one of the ways we are improving energy consumption across the whole site. Using woodchip sourced locally, we produce heat that supplies the entire indoor leisure and dining complex. So, next time you take a dip in our heated pools, you can relax in the knowledge that all the energy comes from our very own biomass boiler.





And that's not all. We have solar panels that create electricity, a borehole that feeds our main toilet block, and our very own bug hotel to encourage our pollinating pals.

Each day we recycle kitchen oil, paper, cardboard, tins, glass, plastic and much more besides. See if you can spot our paper straws and compostable cutlery and glasses...

It's this effort that has led to several environmental awards including a top three spot in the Ethical, Responsible and Sustainable Tourism category at the Visit Devon Tourism Awards 2019/20, twenty one years of David Bellamy Awards and recognition as Plastic Free Champions by Surfers Against Sewage.

Plenty to explore

Cofton is ideally situated to explore the best Devon has to offer. And the best part is, with so many great transport options from buses, trains and cycle paths, you can park up, leave the keys and get ready for adventure without having to worry about what to do with the car.

With train stations in both nearby Starcross and Dawlish Warren, you can ride the rails to Exeter and beyond in one direction or take in the stunning sights of the iconic railway, designed by Isambard Kingdom Brunel, as it travels beneath the sea cliffs of Teignmouth towards Torbay and the English Riviera in the other. Or pack up the bikes and explore the area on two-wheels with the miles of national cycle trails that run right by the park. The flat, mostly traffic free, Exe Estuary Trail will take you straight to the heart of Exeter Quay, and if you are feeling brave all the way round to Exmouth.

For an easier way to reach Exmouth take the Starcross-Exmouth ferry for a leisurely cruise across the Exe Estuary where you'll be greeted by a waft of fresh and inviting seafood scents.
